Directions :

Take Highway 20 east out of Sedro Woolley for approximately 1.8 miles to the Helmick Road. Turn left and go approximately 0.5 miles to Alpine Road and turn left. Alpine road bends to the right but go straight onto Crown Pacific Road # 190. Continue through the gate and take the second road (first maintained road) to the left. Follow this road to where it makes a sharp turn to the right and goes steeply up hill. The next stream this road crosses is this creek, which is well above the anadromous access. See map.


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
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
