

- Trap 2 was placed about midway on the westerly side in about one meter of water.
- Trap 3 was placed in the northerly end of the pond in about one meter of water.
- Trap 4 was placed in the northeasterly portion of the pond near the toe of the terrace in about one meter.
- All traps were baited with salmon roe.

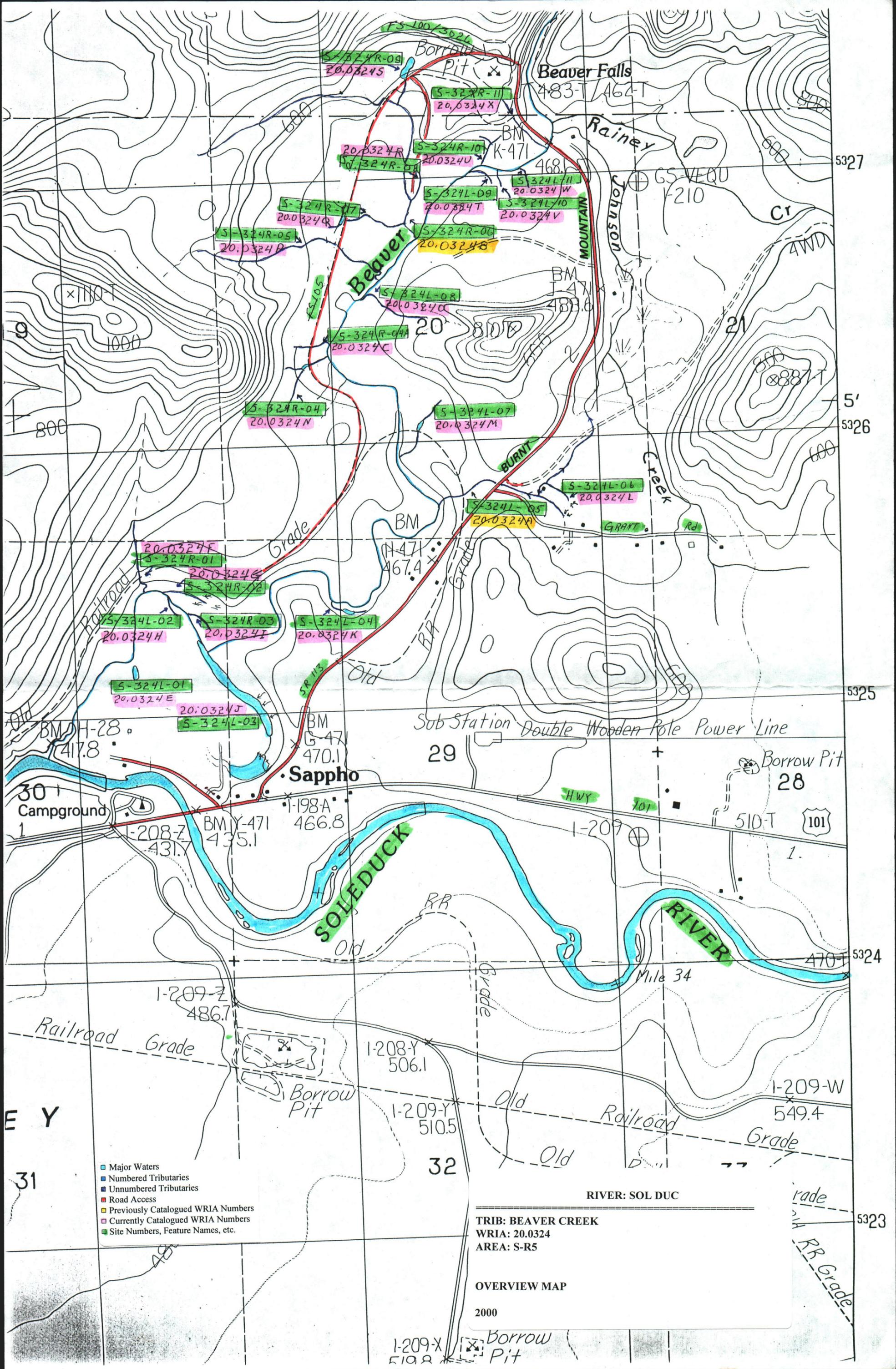
