- The usable habitat in this stream is protected by the RMZ of Beaver Creek. The exceptional quality of the gravel should merit protection as areas of recruitment.



North from Forks to M.P. 203.8. Take a left on Rixon Road and follow for 0.2 miles to a residence on the right (272). After acquiring access permission, follow the depression to the right of the out buildings to the pond. Continue upstream for about 0.2 miles. This stream is the second right bank channel. It is past S-324R-01.


