Take Highway 530 to Darrington, at the light turn left. Go approximately 1/4 mile and turn right onto the Sauk Prairie road and cross over the Sauk River. Stay on Sauk Prairie road past the Crawford Loop road until you cross over Dutch Creek. The site is located above the road 0.1 miles on the right bank.

Area Overview :

Site is a very small intermittent stream that has been ditched for most of it's length across a field and a small pond has been constructed at the point where the two tributaries come together. The site had one redd and one coho carcass on the day of the survey indicating a small amount of use but due to it size and condition there is probably very little fish use.


