Follow the Mountain Loop Highway out of Granite Falls to the Forest Service 4065 road on the right that leads to the trail head for the Sunrise Mine Trail (approximately 0.4 miles past Buck Creek). Go down this road for 0.5 miles to Palmer Creek and park here. Hike downstream to the the SF Stillaguamish R. Hike down the river 0.8 miles to the site on the right bank.

Site is a small partially intermittent terrace tributary that offers a small amount of excellent rearing habitat. Coho fry were very abundant in the wetted portion of the site.


