Describe: Juvenile were observed in large numbers up to the beaver dam at 212 meters, a few were up to the large pond. Redds were observed in the patch gravel.

Describe: Cutthroat have been observed spawning in the springs at the head of the large pond.

#### ENHANCEMENT OPPORTUNITIES


Project type: Pond passage

Equipment access: Poor

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: A two meter drop over a distance of four meters seems to block access into the pond. By carefully placing weirs by hand passage could be improved. Dropping the pond level slightly would help to insure that all of the flow goes into the outlet helping passage. Currently part of the flow goes over the edge of the bench and directly into the river. This could be a small hand labor project.

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

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
