**DIRECTIONS TO SITE:** Head north from Forks on HWY 101 about 3.1 mi. Turn left (west) about 0.1 mi. beyond MP 195 on D-2000. Proceed west on the D-2000 for 6.35 mi. to the D-2600. Turn left on the D-2600 and proceed 2.1 mi. and turn right on the D-5200. Proceed 1.0 mi. on the D-5200 then turn left on D-5230. Proceed 0.3 mi. down D-5230 road and park where culvert has been pulled out of small trib. Continue walking down the 5230 to the W. Fk. Dickey. Proceed down W. Fk. Dickey on the left bank. WD-L2-05 will be the 2nd trib. encountered. The mouth may be dry but will be identified with flagging.

**FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE:** Access is probably good only on high flows during rainy periods - the channel is probably dry all other times. No fish were observed.

**FLOODING POTENTIAL:** This entire system will flood during high flows.

**LANDOWNER:** ITT Rayonier/DNR

**COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:** This stream has:

- Good egress to the river during rainy periods only.
- Drains a shallow and frequently flooded woodland marsh.
- Lies within an older 2nd growth stand of hemlock. Has dense overhead canopy.

**Recommend:** (low priority)

- This system appears to have limited potential do to physical parameters and frequent flooding. No enhancement recommended.

**TYPE & AMOUNT OF IN POND COVER:** Cover is good - typical instream aquatic vegetation found in shallow marshes and ponds, windfalls and other woody debris (limbs), dense streamside brush (salmon berry)

**COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:** This pond is very shallow and could almost be classified as a woodland marsh - it lies within a dense stand of older 2nd growth hemlock and has a dense overhead canopy. This is a beautiful spot, diverse in habitat and probably attracts all forms of wildlife.

Recommendations: None - this area is subject to frequent flooding.






