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**SUBSTRATE TYPE:** Mud/silt, trace of gravel in plunge pools.

**SITE SIZE:** **Length-** 160 m  
**Width-** Water surface = 0.3 - 1.0 m  
Channel = 0.3 - 2.0 m (Channel is braided)  
**Depth-** 5 - 10 cm **Max-** 40 cm

**WATER SOURCE:** Springs

**DIRECTIONS TO SITE:** Go north from Forks on Hwy 101 about 8.4 mi. then turn left at the Lake Pleasant Grocery Store (0.4 mi. north of MP 200) onto Lake Pleasant Rd. Stay on the main road going past the community park and across the Lake Cr. bridge. Turn right and continue up the county road (along the N.W. shore of the lake) to the end of the pavement. This road then becomes the 9000 line. Continue on the 9000 for 16.5 mi. to a gate (just past the jct of the D-5000, an R-2 key is required to get through the gate. The key can be acquired at the Rayonier Inc office). Continue through the gate for 1.4 mi. Turn left onto an unmarked road (may have gate at the intersection) for 0.4 mi. There will be a cable gate (private property: owner is Mark Davis). Walk down to the clearing bear south to Sands Creek then follow Sands Creek to Dickey Lake, then southerly along the lake shore for about 25 m to WD-L5-02.

**FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE:** Fair egress. Fish have unrestricted access. Attraction is poor due to low flows. A salmonid (1+) was observed in the channel.

**FLOODING POTENTIAL:** Moderate, backwaters from the lake at times.

**LANDOWNER:** Unknown possibly Rayonier Timberlands or Davis.

**COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Comments:

- Lies within 20 m of Sands Cr.
- A good canopy is forming from deciduous species.

Recommendations:

- Observe summer flows.
- May be able to blast some pools.
- Maintain integrity of the stream.


