WATER SOURCE: The primary water source is small associated wetlands on the terrace.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Head north from Forks on Hwy 101. Turn left just beyond mp 193 (1.0 mi. north of Forks) onto the La Push Rd. Proceed west on the La Push Rd about 3.1 miles. Turn right onto the Quillayute Rd. and continue west for 4.0 mi. Turn right onto Mina Smith Rd. (at Quillayute Cemetery) and proceed north about 0.8 mi. Turn left (west), after crossing the Colby Cr. bridge, onto the D-5000 line. Proceed along the D-5000 for about 6.1 mi. (0.4 mi. beyond MP 10) to the jct. of the D-5210. There is a gate and it will probably be locked. The key is available at the ITT Rayonier office. Proceed down the D-5210 for about 1.9 mi. to a spur road off to the right (it is getting grown over). Go down this road to the first culvert crossing. This is WD-R1-05.

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: This channel has a nice egress into a glide. No fish were observed.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Low. Some backwater flooding will affect the lower most reach but this will help passage over several small cascades.


LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time (probably ITT Rayonier)

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: This channel has:

- A nice egress into a glide.
- A moderately - gentle gradient.
- A "V" shaped valley
- Poor shade, no RMZ and the conifer plantation is only about ten years old.
- moderate to low flows most of the time.

Recommend:

- Potential for a series of controls in the channel.
- Maintain the integrity stream.


