**DIRECTIONS TO SITE:** Head north from Forks on HWY 101. Turn left on La Push road 0.75 mi. past the Calawah bridge. Proceed 3.1 mi. down La Push road and turn right on Quillayute Prairie road. Continue for 3.95 mi. and turn right on Mina Smith road at the cemetery. Continue for 0.8 mi. and turn left onto the logging road D-5000, proceed for 9.2 mi. Turn right on the D-5230 and proceed 3.4 mi. to the end of the road. Walk downstream along the RB of the Dickey to the first riverine pond.

**FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE:** The egress has some cascades that are a problem on low flows, but will be inundated during higher flows. Very little attraction water also. No fish were observed.

**FLOODING POTENTIAL:** Moderate, Pond will backwater during high events.

**LANDOWNER:** Unknown at this time, probably ITT Rayonier

**COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:** This stream has:

- Excellent overwinter habitat if marsh is accessible.
- Could trap a lot of smolts during a dry spring.
- Dark, tea colored water.
- A low gradient.
- Very little shade.

**Recommend:**

- Maintain integrity of the stream.

**COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:** Minnow trap to see if fry are using the pond. Observe in the summer to see if pond stays watered.






