WATER SOURCE: Springs, surface runoff.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Starting from the Calawah River Bridge on Hwy 101. Drive north for about 0.75 mi., thence left on the La Push road for 3.1 mi. to the Quillayute Prairie Road, thence right on the Quillayute Prairie Road, for 3.9 mi. to the Mina Smith Road, thence right on the Mina Smith Road, at the cemetery, for 0.8 mi. to the D-5000, thence left on the D-5000, a mainline logging road, for 9.2 mi. to the D-5230, thence right on the D-5230 (if there is a gate it may be locked, the key can be obtained from the Rayonier office) for 1.3 mi. to the D-5231, thence left on the D-5231 for 1.4 mi. to a short spur road to the right (east). Park and walk an easterly bearing to the W.F. Dickey River. If WD-R3-02 is not encountered by time the river is reached then follow the RB upstream to the mouth of WD-R3-02.

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: Good egress. No fish were observed.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Lower end of stream susceptible to back water flooding.

LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time probably, Rayonier, Inc.




COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:


- Stable marsh lands above 4 m.
- A gentle gradient.
- Lower reach is covered with wood debris, small conifers, and sedges.
- Upper reach is covered by alders, wood debris, small conifers, and sedges.
- Marsh ends ~145 m into an area of intermittent standing water.
- This stretch of river is lacking in habitat.

Recommend:

- Due to stability of marshlands and lack of habitat in area, a beaded channel is suggested.
- Maintain the integrity of the stream.
