

Driving Directions to Meetings Regarding Gray Wolf Recovery, Management

Jan. 17 – Office Building #2, at 14th Ave. and Jefferson St., Olympia, 2:30-5 p.m.

From North:

Take I-5 South toward Portland. Take the 105A exit toward the State Capitol/City Center. Merge onto 14th Avenue, move one lane to the left, and continue straight through the roundabout and through the tunnel. Turn right onto Capitol Way South. Take the first right onto 11th Avenue SE. Continue through the light and take the first right into the parking garage. Orange signs direct traffic to visitor parking on the top floor of the garage. Parking fees are \$1.50 per hour and require exact change.

Signs will direct meeting participants from the parking lot to the meeting room.

From South:

Take I-5 North toward Seattle. Take the 105A exit toward the State Capitol/City Center. Merge onto 14th Avenue, and continue straight through the roundabout and through the tunnel. Turn right onto Capitol Way South. Take the first right onto 11th Avenue SE. Continue through the light and take the first right into the parking garage. Orange signs direct traffic to visitor parking on the top floor of the garage. Parking fees are \$1.50 per hour and require exact change.

Signs will direct meeting participants from the parking lot to the meeting room.

Overflow parking can be found across 11th Avenue at the ProArts Building. Additional parking options are noted on the Washington State Capitol Campus map in yellow.
