

Sport Fishing Rules Pamphlet Corrections

May 1, 2013 through April 30, 2014

Marine Area 4 (Updated May 9, 2013)

P. 104 Bottomfish section, Rockfish Under additional rules the statement “(except when HALIBUT is open)” is incorrectly listed for the dates May 1-Sept. 30.

The correction to this rule is the removal of “(except when HALIBUT is open).”

May 1–Sept. 30: Anglers MAY NOT retain or possess rockfish at any time when fishing seaward of a line approximating 20 fathoms.

Page 57 – Wind River (Skamania County) (Updated August 29, 2013)

Clarification: Clarifies the daily catch limits and regulations for retaining hatchery and wild fish in the ALL SPECIES section.

The ALL SPECIES section should read: Aug. 1-Oct. 31: from the mouth to Hwy. 14 Bridge, the daily catch limit and retention regulations for hatchery and wild fish follows the most liberal regulations of the mainstem Columbia or Wind rivers when both areas are open concurrently for SALMON. Mar. 16-June 30: night closure. May 1-June 30: anti-snagging rule from Burlington Northern Railroad Bridge upstream. Aug. 1-Oct. 31: anti-snagging rule. When anti-snagging rule is in effect, only fish hooked inside the mouth may be retained.

Page 84 – White Salmon River (Klickitat/Skamania counties) (Updated August 29, 2013)

Clarification: Clarifies the daily catch limits and regulations for retaining hatchery and wild fish in the ALL SPECIES section.

The ALL SPECIES section should read: From the mouth to Hwy. 14 Bridge: bank fishing only; the daily catch limit and retention regulations for hatchery and wild fish follows the most liberal regulations of the mainstem Columbia or Wind rivers when both areas are open concurrently for SALMON. Aug. 1-Dec. 31: anti-snagging rule.
