

Sport Fishing Rules Pamphlet Corrections

July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016

Puget Sound Rivers (Updated August 13, 2015)

Page 30 Puyallup River (Pierce Co.) from East Main Avenue Bridge to the Carbon River The salmon season is incorrectly listed without additional pink salmon retention.

CORRECT SEASON SALMON August 1-December 31: Minimum size 12". Daily limit 6. Up to 2 adults **plus 2 additional PINK** may be retained. Release wild adult CHINOOK.

Page 3 New for 2015, Skagit River (Skagit Co.) from Highway 536 at Mount Vernon (Memorial Highway Bridge to mouth of Gilligan Creek: The salmon season is incorrectly listed as June 15-July 16, 2015. Note: the season is listed correctly on page 23.

CORRECT SEASON SALMON **June 16-July 15, 2015:** Minimum size 12". Daily limit 3 SOCKEYE only. Season may close earlier if guideline is attained. Refer to wdfw.wa.gov.

Page 28 Snoqualmie River (King Co.) from mouth to boat ramp at Plum access, and from boat ramp at Plum access to Snoqualmie Falls: The salmon season is incorrectly listed as a coho only fishery and without additional pink salmon retention.

CORRECT SEASON SALMON September 1-December 31: Minimum size 12". Daily limit **3 plus 1 additional PINK**. Release CHINOOK and CHUM.

Columbia Basin Rivers (Updated September 14, 2015)

Page 57 Cowlitz River (Cowlitz/Lewis) from boundary markers at mouth to Mayfield Dam: The barbless hook requirement was incorrectly omitted for waters downstream of Lexington Drive Bridge (Sparks Road Bridge) at Lexington for the months of July 2015 and June 2016.

CORRECT REQUIREMENT From boundary markers at mouth to Lexington Drive Bridge (Sparks Road Bridge) at Lexington: barbless hooks required year-round for SALMON, STEELHEAD, and CUTTHROAT.

Page 68 Grande Ronde River (Asotin Co.) from mouth to County Road Bridge (about 2.5 miles upstream): The trout season is incorrectly listed with year-round hatchery steelhead retention. There are two separate seasons.

CORRECT SEASONS

TROUT January 1-April 15: Minimum size 10". Daily limit 2, except up to 3 hatchery STEELHEAD may be retained. No minimum size for TROUT with clipped adipose fin and a healed scar at the location of the clipped fin. Mandatory hatchery STEELHEAD retention.

TROUT April 16-December 31: Minimum size 10" maximum size 20". Daily limit 2. No minimum size for TROUT with clipped adipose fin and a healed scar at the location of the clipped fin.

Westside Lakes (Updated July 14, 2015)

Page 82 Mayfield Lake (Reservoir) from Mayfield Dam to Mossyrock Dam: An additional daily limit on the trout season was incorrectly omitted.

CORRECT SEASON TROUT Year-round: Minimum size 8". Daily limit 5 **except September 1-Last day in February: daily limit 10**. Release CUTTHROAT. Release RAINBOW TROUT except those having a clipped adipose fin and a healed scar at the location of the clipped fin.
