Columbia River and Tributary Fishery Reports

Updates: Mainstem and tributary:

Salmon/Steelhead:

Columbia River Mainstem

- **Buoy 10 upstream to Chief Joseph Dam:** Effective June 1, 2019 until further notice, barbless hooks are now voluntary for salmon and steelhead directed fisheries.
- Megler-Astoria Bridge upstream to Hwy 395 Bridge at Pasco: Effective June 16 through June 30, 2019, the daily limit is 2 hatchery steelhead. Release all salmon. Effective July 1 through July 31, 2019, the daily limit is 1 hatchery steelhead. Salmon and steelhead night fishing closure. Release all salmon.
- Hwy 395 Bridge at Pasco upstream to Priest Rapids Dam: Effective June 16 through August 15, 2019, salmon and steelhead closed.

SALMON & STEELHEAD

Columbia River Tributaries

- Effective June 1, barbless hooks are voluntary for salmon and steelhead directed fisheries in some tributaries to the Columbia River from Buoy 10 to McNary Dam. For a complete list of rivers and areas where barbed hooks are allowed please visit the Emergency Rules section of the WDFW website.
- **Kalama River:** until further notice, from the mouth to 1,000 feet below the fishway at the upper salmon hatchery: the daily salmon limit is 6 fish, of which only 1 may be an adult.
- Lewis River: Until further notice, from the mouth to Merwin dam: Closed to salmon retention.
- Wind River: Until further notice, from the mouth to 800 yards below Carson National Fish Hatchery: Closed to salmon and steelhead angling.
- **Drano Lake:** Until further notice, downstream of the markers on point of land downstream and across from Little White Salmon National fish hatchery and upstream of Highway 14 bridge: Closed to salmon and steelhead angling.
- Klickitat River: Until further notice, from the mouth to boundary markers below Klickitat Salmon hatchery: closed to salmon retention.

Sturgeon:

• Buoy 10 upstream to McNary Dam including adjacent tributaries: Closed to retention of white sturgeon but remains open for catch and release fishing only.

Fishery Reports:

Salmon/Steelhead:

Columbia River mainstem

Bank and boat anglers are catching steelhead from Longview downstream to Cathlamet.

Shad:

On the Washington shore over 850 bank anglers just below Bonneville Dam were counted on last Saturday's flight. Yesterday's dam count was close to 355,000 which brings the season total up to nearly 3.9 million to date.

Salmon/Steelhead:

Columbia River Tributaries

Elochoman River- 6 bank anglers kept 3 steelhead.

Cowlitz River – I-5 Br downstream: 15 bank rods kept 2 steelhead.

Above the I-5 Br: 8 bank rods released 1 steelhead. 18 boats/46 rods kept 17 steelhead.

Tacoma Power employees recovered 49 spring Chinook adults, 10 spring Chinook jacks, 22 summer-run steelhead adults, two winter-run steelhead adults, and one cutthroat trout during five days of operations at the Cowlitz Salmon Hatchery separator.

During the past week Tacoma Power employees released eight spring Chinook adults and five spring Chinook jacks into Lake Scanewa located in Randle and they released one cutthroat trout into the Tilton River in Morton.

To date, Tacoma Power employees have recycled 96 summer-run steelhead to the lower river.

River flows at Mayfield Dam are approximately 2,960 cubic feet per second on Monday, June 10. Water visibility is 11 feet and the water temperature is 50 F.

Kalama River – 44 bank anglers kept 2 Chinook, 2 steelhead and released 2 steelhead. 1 boat/2 rods had no catch.

Lewis River – 2 bank anglers had no catch. 3 boats/4 rods kept 1 steelhead.

Klickitat below Fisher Hill Bridge – 3 bank anglers kept 1 Chinook jack.

Klickitat above #5 Fishway – 8 bank anglers had no catch. 1 boat/2 rods released 2 steelhead.
