Columbia River and Tributary Fishery Reports

Updates:

SALMON & STEELHEAD

Columbia River Mainstem

• Warrior Rock to Bonneville Dam, Effective September 6 until further notice. Release all Chinook, 2 hatchery adult coho may be retained.

Columbia River Tributaries

- **Cowlitz River**: Until further notice, the closed waters section below the Cowlitz Salmon Hatchery Barrier Dam is 400 feet, at the posted markers.
- **North Fork Toutle River**: Until further notice: Daily salmon limit 6, up to 4 adults may be retained. Release all salmon other than hatchery coho.
- Wind River: Effective September 1 September 30, 2019, from the mouth to 400 feet downstream of Shipherd Falls fish ladder: release all steelhead.
- White Salmon River: Effective September 1 September 30, 2019, from the mouth to the county road bridge below the former location of the power house: release all steelhead.
- **Klickitat River**: Effective through September 30, 2019, from the mouth to Fisher Hill Bridge: release all steelhead.

Sturgeon:

- Buoy 10 upstream to McNary Dam including adjacent tributaries: Closed to retention of white sturgeon but remains open for catch and release fishing only.
- Columbia River from Wauna powerlines upstream to Bonneville Dam, and the Cowlitz River —
 White Sturgeon is open for retention on Saturday, September 21 and Saturday September 28,
 2019, only. Minimum size 44" fork length, maximum size 50" fork length. Daily limit 1. Catchand-release fishing for sturgeon will continue to be allowed on all non-retention days.

Fishery Reports:

Salmon/Steelhead:

Columbia River Tributaries

Elochoman River – 2 bank anglers had no catch.

Cowlitz River – I-5 Br downstream – 46 bank rods kept 1 coho, 2 coho jacks and released 1 Chinook jack. 33 boats/86 rods kept 8 coho, 3 coho jacks and released 83 Chinook, 23 Chinook jacks,12 coho, 14 coho jacks and 3 steelhead.

Above the I-5 Br – 19 bank rods released 2 Chinook. 1 boat/2 rods had no catch.

Tacoma Power employees recovered 102 coho adults, 31 coho jacks, 96 fall Chinook adults, six fall Chinook jacks, 48 summer-run steelhead adults, one summer-run steelhead jack, 11 cutthroat trout, 10 spring Chinook adults and four spring Chinook mini-jacks during five days of operations at the Cowlitz Salmon Hatchery separator.

During the past week Tacoma Power employees released nine coho adults, three coho jacks, and three spring Chinook adults into the Cispus River located near Randle and they released three spring Chinook adults, 12 coho adults, two coho jacks, and two cutthroat trout at the Franklin Bridge release site in Packwood.

Tacoma Power also released 43 fall Chinook adults, 30 coho adults, 20 coho jacks, and one cutthroat trout into the Tilton River at Gust Backstrom Park in Morton.

To date, Tacoma Power employees have recycled 644 summer-run steelhead to the lower Cowlitz River.

Lewis River – 45 bank anglers kept 1 Chinook, 2 coho, 3 coho jacks and 1 steelhead. 2 boats/4 rods kept 2 coho, 1 coho jack and released 1 Chinook.

Wind River – 2 bank anglers had no catch. 5 boats/6 rods kept 2 Chinook, 1 coho and released 2 coho.

Drano Lake – 15 boats/33 rods kept 18 Chinook and 1 coho.

Klickitat River – 6 bank anglers kept 1 coho and released 1 Chinook.
