

Description: These parcels add to a current pass-through project and protect habitat for Oregon Spotted Frog. Part conservation easement, part fee title purchase (property rights to be held by a partner organization).

Species/Habitat Benefits: Oregon spotted frog, overall pass-through project protects 95% of unprotected privately owned Oregon spotted frog egg-laying habitat in South Puget Sound and is part of South Puget Sound Working Lands for Wildlife collaborative landscape conservation effort.

Additional Project Benefits: Allows continued on-going compatible working land practices.
