- Approximately 2/3 of this proposed project was previously approved in the 2016 Lands 20/20 cycle and is being added here to extend its approval timeline
- Various fish and waterfowl species protected, including the endemic Olympic Mudminnow, Coho salmon, and other salmonids
- Recreation opportunities for hunting, hiking, and wildlife viewing
- Supported by Ducks Unlimited, Migratory Bird Stamp and Art Program
