Mainstem Columbia River

Salmon/Steelhead:

Sec 1 (Bonneville) – 11 bank anglers had no catch.

Sec 2 (Camas/Washougal) – 16 boats/29 rods released one Chinook.

Sec 3 (I-5 area) – Two bank anglers had no catch. 3 boats/7 rods had no catch.

Sec 4 (Vancouver) – 29 bank anglers kept seven Chinook. 22 boats/41 rods kept 12 Chinook and one Chinook jack.
