## **Executive Summary**

A total of 163 bass fishing contests sponsored by 43 bass clubs or other organizations were held in 2004. The bass contests were held on 43 different bodies of water and the majority of the contests were held on the Columbia River system. A total of 18,807 bass were caught (largemouth and smallmouth bass). The average weight per bass was 1.94 pounds. The largest largemouth bass caught was 7.52 pounds and the largest smallmouth bass caught was 6.43 pounds. The overall catch rate was 0.23 fish per hour and 97.9% of the bass caught were reported released alive. The total value of prizes awarded was estimated at \$315,552.

A total of seven walleye fishing contests were held in 2004 and were sponsored by seven walleye clubs or other organizations. The contests were held on five different bodies of water. A total of 3,107 walleye were caught. The average weight per walleye was 2.23 pounds. The largest walleye caught was 13.12 pounds. The overall catch rate was 0.15 fish per hour. Excluding a non catch and released tournament from percent walleye released alive computations, 98.0% of the walleye caught were reported to be released alive. The total value of prizes awarded was estimated at \$182,184.

## **Contest Activity**

#### **Bass Contests**

A total of 163 bass fishing contests were held in Washington State during 2004 (Table 1). This was down from the previous year (181 contests). The average number of bass contests held in Washington during the past five years (2000-2004) was 172. For the previous ten years (1990-1999) the average was 144, and for the ten years preceding (1980-1989), the average was 74. The number of contests per year for the entire 25-year period was 121.

## **Walleye Contests**

Seven walleye contests were held in 2004, one each sponsored by Big Wally's (BW), Central Washington Fish Advisory Committee (CWFAC), Lower Columbia Walleye Club (LCWC), The Meseberg Family (TMF), Lake Roosevelt Walleye Club (LRWC), Northport Chamber of Commerce (NPCC), and the Spokane Walleye Club (SWC).

## Location

#### **Bass Contests**

Bass fishing contests were held on 43 different waters in 2004. The greatest number of contests in 2004 were held on Banks Lake (15), Columbia River (32), Potholes Reservoir (16), Lake Washington (9), and Lake Whatcom (9) (Tables 4a and 4b). Please refer to the attached Appendices for a complete summary of all bass and walleye fishing contest activities in 2004.

#### **Walleye Contests**


One walleye contest each was held at Banks Lake, the Columbia River (below Bonneville Dam), Moses Lake, and Potholes Reservoir. Three walleye contests each were held at Lake Roosevelt.

## **Timing**

#### **Bass Contests**


**Figure 1.** Number and monthly distribution of bass contests held in Washington State, 2004.

At least one bass fishing contest was held during every month except January, February, and December in 2004 (Figure 1). Most of the contest activity occurred between April and September, which is consistent with previous years. The highest level of contest activity was recorded in May (32), followed by June (29), April (24), July and August (23 each), and September (22). This pattern is slightly different from last year, but the pattern of contest activity has remained very similar since the mid-1980s.

Walleye fishing contests in 2004 were held in the months of May (2), June (2), July (1), August (1), and September (1).

## **Total Catch**

#### **Bass Contests**

The combined total number of largemouth bass and smallmouth bass weighed in at all contests held in Washington during 2004 was 18,807. However, some contests combined largemouth and smallmouth bass data. For contests that did not combine data, data was available for 12,141 bass. Sixty-seven percent (8,039) were smallmouth and 33% were largemouth (4,102). The 2004 catch marks the 13th time in 25 years that the catch of smallmouth bass exceeded that of largemouth bass. Prior to 1988, contest relative abundance favored largemouth bass (Figure 2). The percentage of smallmouth bass relative to largemouth bass caught by contest anglers has increased dramatically since the late 1980s, and has been dominant since 1996.

## Fish Size

#### **Bass Contests**

The average size for all bass weighed from fishing contests held in Washington State in 2004 was 1.94 pounds (Table 5). This combined average of largemouth bass and smallmouth bass was the same as last year. The largest largemouth bass weighed in during 2004 was 7.52 pounds and was caught in Silver Lake, Cowlitz County. The largest smallmouth bass was 6.01 pounds and was caught in Osoyoos Lake, Okanogan County.

#### **Walleye Contests**

A total of 3,107 walleye were caught in 2004. The weight of the largest size walleye recorded was 13.12 pounds and was caught in the Columbia River (Lake Roosevelt). The weight of the smallest walleye recorded was 0.96 pounds and was also caught in the Columbia River (Lake Roosevelt).

#### Catch Rate

#### **Bass Contests**

The overall average combined catch rate for largemouth bass and smallmouth bass fishing contests held in Washington State in 2004 was 0.23 fish per hour (Table 6), which was a decrease from the previous year.

#### **Walleye Contests**

The average catch rate for all contests in 2004 was 0.15 fish per hour (Table 7). This was considerably lower than what was reported in 2003. The average catch rate was 0.09 fish per hour for Banks Lake, 0.09 fish per hour for the Columbia River (below Bonneville Dam), 0.19 fish per hour for Moses Lake, 0.12 fish per hour for Potholes Reservoir, and 0.19 fish per hour for Lake Roosevelt. However, one of the Lake Roosevelt contests had an extremely low catch rate (.01 fish per hour). If this contest were to be removed from the data set, the catch rate would increase to 0.027 fish per hour.

## Percent Released

#### **Bass Contests**

A total of 98% of all bass weighed in during contests held in 2004 were released alive and reported in good condition. This percentage was just slightly down from last year's figure (99%), but slightly above the 24-year average. Live release rates for smallmouth bass are nearly always lower than those for largemouth bass, presumably due to a higher incidence of handling mortality. However, it was surprising to note that when the survival rates for both largemouth bass and smallmouth bass were compared since 1996, there was not a noticeable difference overall (Table 8).

### **Walleye Contests**

A total of 98.0% of all walleye weighed in during contests held in 2004 were released alive and reported in good condition (Table 9). This figure was based on six contests because one contest was not catch and release and it was excluded from percent survival computations. This was the same percentage as last year and was also equal to the 10-year average.


#### Prize Value

#### **Bass Contests**

The total value of prizes offered for bass fishing contests was estimated at \$315,552 in 2004, or an average of \$2,337 per contest. This was based on 135 contests. Although there were 163 contests held in 2004, information on the total value of prizes given was missing from 28 of them. This year's average was down from the 2003 average of \$3,028. Prize values ranged from \$0.00 to a high of \$47,166.

#### **Walleye Contests**

The total value of prizes offered for walleye contests in 2004 was estimated at \$182,184, or \$26,026 per contest. This total amount was up from the amount awarded in 2003 (\$135,923). The average value per contest was also greater than last year's (\$19,418). Prize values ranged from a low of \$500 to a high of \$42,000.
