**Stocking Month:** Exact dates are not known at this time. Stocking timing will be left to the convenience of the hatcheries.

**Fish Species:** CT=cutthroat trout, LCT=lahontan cutthroat BT=brown trout, EBT=eastern brook trout, TEBT = triploid eastern brook trout, RB=rainbow trout, TRB=triploid rainbow trout, KOK=kokanee, and TT=tiger trout

**Fishing Season:** OD=Last Saturday in April, YR=Year-Round ( regardless of the season listed it is the **Anglers responsibility** to check the "Fishing in Washington" pamphlet to assure compliance with the regulations.

**Fry/Fingerling:** Trout that have been reared at WDFW facilities that were released at 10 to 1000 fish per pound.
