## **Executive Summary**

A total of 163 bass fishing contests sponsored by 45 bass clubs or other organizations were held in 2015. The bass contests were held on 48 different bodies of water with the majority of the contests being held on the Columbia River system. A total of 17,110 bass were caught (Largemouth and Smallmouth bass). The average weight per bass was 2.13 pounds. The largest Largemouth Bass caught was 8.00 pounds and the largest Smallmouth Bass caught was 6.70 pounds. The overall catch rate was 0.27 fish per hour and 99% of the bass caught were reported as having been released alive. The total value of prizes awarded was estimated at \$324,812.

A total of seven Walleye fishing contests were held in 2015 and were sponsored by seven Walleye clubs or other organizations. The contests were held on six different bodies of water. A total of 2,895 Walleye were caught. The average weight per Walleye was 2.47 pounds. The largest Walleye caught was 13.24 pounds. The overall catch rate was 0.32 fish per hour and 96% of the Walleye caught were reported as having been released alive. The total value of prizes awarded was estimated at \$109,715.

# **Contest Activity**

#### **Bass Contests**

A total of 166 permits were issued for bass fishing contests in 2015. However, the number of contests held was less than the number of permits issued due to three contests being canceled. Three other contests consisted of more than one event, but for reporting purposes, each event was treated as a separate contest. Thus, the actual number of contests held in Washington State during 2015 was 163 (Table 1). This was an increase of three contests from the previous year (160 contests). The average number of bass contests per year in Washington since 2010 was 183. From 2000 to 2009, the average was 176 contests per year. From 1990 to 1999 the average was 144 contests per year, and for the first ten years of fishing contest data reporting (1980-1989), the average was 74 contests per year. The number of contests per year for the entire 36-year period was 140. We received final reports from all but four contests.

#### Location

#### **Bass Contests**




Figure 1. The total number of water bodies per year on which bass fishing contests have been held, 1990-2015. There is no data for 1997.




Figure 2. The total number of contests by pool for the five Columbia River pools that held bass fishing contests in 2015.

Bass fishing contests were held on 48 different water bodies in the state during 2015, the same total as 2014 (Figure 1). Since 1990, the smallest number of bodies of water to hold contests was 30, which was in 1990. The greatest number of bodies of water to hold a contest was 52, which has occurred three times (1996, 2012, and 2013). The average number of different bodies of water per year to hold contests is 40. The water bodies with the greatest number of contests (≥10) in 2015 were: the Columbia River (20), Lake Washington (18), Banks Lake (17), Potholes Reservoir (16), and Moses Lake (10) (Table 5). Since 1990, Banks Lake and Potholes Reservoir have been the two most popular bodies of water to hold fishing contests. They have averaged 18 and 15 contests per year, respectively. Additionally, Lake Washington has averaged 17 contests per year since 2012. Five Columbia River pools, Bonneville Lake, Lake Pateros, Lake Roosevelt, and Lake Umatilla held contests in 2015. Lake Wallula and Lake Roosevelt were the two popular bodies of water with eight and seven contests, respectively (Figure 2). Walleye contests were held on six different water bodies in the state in 2015. Banks Lake, Moses Lake, Potholes Reservoir, Lake Umatilla, and Lake Wallula each held one contest. Lake Roosevelt held two contests. Please refer to the Appendix 3 for a complete summary of all Walleye fishing contest activities in 2015.

# **Monthly Activity**

#### **Bass Contests**




Figure 3. Number of bass contests by month held in Washington State in 2015.

At least one bass fishing contest was held during every month of 2015 except January (Figure 3). Most of the contest activity occurred between April and October, which is consistent with previous years. The highest level of contest activity was recorded in May (30), followed by August (27), September (24), June (23), April (22), July (17), and October (12). This pattern is similar to last year and the general pattern of contest activity since the mid-1980s.

#### **Walleye Contests**




Figure 4. Number of Walleye contests by month held in Washington State in 2015.

Walleye fishing contests were held during five months in 2015 (Figure 4). This was one less month than in 2014. May, June, and September all tied for the most contest activity (2), which was the same as in 2014. This pattern has remained fairly consistent since the mid-1990s.

#### **Total Catch**

#### **Bass Contests**

The total number of bass (Largemouth and Smallmouth combined) weighed in at all contests held in Washington during 2015 was 17,110. This was a seven percent increase from the number reported in 2014. All of the contests were able to provide the number of Largemouth Bass and Smallmouth Bass weighed in. However, 39 contests were not able to provide separate total weights for each species and therefore provided a combined total weight. Of the 17,110 bass that were weighed in, 68% (11,628) were Smallmouth Bass and 32% were Largemouth Bass (5,536).




Figure 5. Percent of Largemouth and Smallmouth Bass by year from bass fishing contests held in Washington from 1980-2015.

The 2015 catch marks the 23th time in 36 years that the catch of Smallmouth Bass exceeded that of Largemouth Bass. Prior to 1988, contest relative abundance favored Largemouth Bass (Figure 5). The percentage of Smallmouth Bass relative to Largemouth Bass caught by contest anglers has increased dramatically since the mid-1980s, and has been dominant since 1997.

The total number of Walleye weighed in all contests held in Washington during 2015 was 2,895. This was almost a nine percent increase from 2014 (Table 5).

#### Fish Size

#### **Bass Contests**

The average size for all bass weighed from fishing contests held in Washington State in 2015 was 2.13 pounds per fish (Table 7). This combined average of Largemouth Bass and Smallmouth Bass weight per fish, was slightly less (< 0.1pounds) than the 2014 average. The largest Largemouth Bass weighed during 2015 was 8.00 pounds and was caught in Lake Sacajawea (Franklin and Walla Walla Counties). The largest Smallmouth Bass weighed during 2015 was 6.70 pounds and was caught in Lake Whatcom (Whatcom County).

#### **Walleye Contests**

The average weight per fish for all Walleye weighed from fishing contests held in Washington in 2015 was 2.13 pounds (Table 8). The average weight of Walleye caught in Banks Lake was 2.56 pounds; Moses Lake was 2.24 pounds; Potholes Reservoir was 2.88 pounds; Lake Roosevelt was 1.38 pounds; and Lake Wallula was 3.82 pounds. The weight of the largest size Walleye weighed during 2015 was 13.24 pounds and was caught in Lake Wallula (Benton County).

The average weight per fish for all Walleye weighed in was slightly heavier that the total number of Walleye weighed in in 2014. The average weight of Walleye caught in Banks Lake in 2015 was almost half a pound less than last year's average. The average weight of Walleye caught in Moses Lake was slightly over half a pound more than 1.65 pounds per fish average in 2014. The average weight of Walleye caught in Potholes Reservoir was almost a pound greater than the

2.01 pounds-per-fish average in 2014. The average weight of Walleye caught in Lake Roosevelt was slightly less than the 1.58 pounds-per-fish average as in 2014. The average weight of Walleye caught in Lake Wallula was about 1.00 pound lower than the 4.81 pounds per fish average in 2014.

#### **Catch Rate**

#### **Bass Contests**

The overall combined average catch rate (catch per unit of effort or CPUE) for Largemouth Bass and Smallmouth Bass for bass fishing contests held in Washington State in 2015 was 0.27 fish per hour (Table 9), which was the same as the rate in 2014. The catch rate is determined by the total number of fish weighed in divided by the total angler hours.

### **Walleye Contests**

The average catch rate (CPUE) for all Walleye contests combined in 2015 was 0.32 fish per hour (Table 10). This was a little higher that what was reported in 2014. The CPUE for Banks Lake was 0.22 fish per hour, which was an increase in the catch rate from 2014. The CPUE for Moses Lake was 0.28 fish per hour, which was slightly less than the catch rate reported in 2014. The CPUE for Potholes Reservoir was 0.61 fish per hour, which was almost an increase by a factor of two in the catch rate in 2014. The CPUE for Lake Roosevelt was 0.28 fish per hour, which was a slight decrease in the rate reported in 2014. The CPUE for Lake Umatilla was 0.14 fish per hour. There was no previous data to compare to. The CPUE for Lake Wallula was 0.31 fish per hour, which was slightly more than the catch rate in 2014. The catch rate is determined similarly to bass contests. The total number of fish weighed in is divided by the total angler hours.

#### **Percent Released**

#### **Bass Contests**

Of the 17,110 bass weighed during contests held in 2015, 16,395 were reported as being released alive and in good condition (Table 11). This percentage was the same percentage that was reported in 2014 and is two percent higher than the 35-year average. When comparing the survival rates between Largemouth Bass and Smallmouth Bass since 1996, there has not been a noticeable difference.

Of the 2,661 Walleye weighed during contests held in 2015, 98% were reported as being released alive and in good condition (Table 12). This was the same percentage as 2014 and the 20-year average.

#### **Prize Value**

#### **Bass Contests**

The total value of prizes offered for bass fishing contests held in Washington in 2015 was estimated at \$324,812 or an average of \$2,165 per contest. Although final reports were received from 159 contests, these figures were based on 150 contests. The 2015 total amount is just over two times the 2014 total (\$141,016) and the average per contest was almost two and one half times the 2014 average of \$892. Prize values ranged from \$0.00 (12 contests) to a high of \$38,000 (Appendix 1).

#### **Walleye Contests**

The total value of prizes offered for Walleye contests held in Washington in 2015 was estimated at \$109,715 or an average of \$18,286 per contest. This total amount was lower than the amount awarded in 2014 (\$112,701), but the average value per contest was slightly higher than in 2014 (\$14,088). Prize values ranged from a low of \$500 to a high of \$28,650 (Appendix 3).

#### **Discussion**

The number of bass contests held in 2015 was very similar to the number of contests held in 2014, which was the first year in which the full effect of the new \$70 per application fee was felt. This suggests that the increase in the application fee may have resulted in fewer contests. The total amount of prizes awarded in 2015 was considerably higher than the amount awarded the previous year. Almost 2.5 times higher. This could be an indication that the economy has been doing better, which probably allowed the sponsors to contribute more or higher value prizes. Additionally, gas prices were lower, so that may have allowed more anglers to afford more tournaments number-wise and/or distance-wise. Final report submission compliance was not 100% this past year as there were four outstanding final reports.

The number of Walleye contests held in 2015 (seven) was consistent with the long term level of activity. Although there has been slight fluctuations in the number of contests from year to year, there have always been a low number of Walleye clubs and contest sponsors statewide, when compared with the number of bass clubs, therefore far fewer contests occur. There was a slight decrease in the percent of Walleye that were released alive after the weigh in (2% lower than in 2014). It might be attributed to two contests that had a mortality rate of close to 10%, which is the maximum allowed under the fishing contest rules (WAC 232-12-168). This was most likely attributed to having hotter than normal temperatures, which hampered the ability of anglers to keep their Walleye alive and in good condition in their livewells. In addition, one contest may have had a few flaws in its weigh in procedure. Final Report compliance for the Walleye contests was excellent as usual (100%).
