Fry/Fingerling: Trout or kokanee that have been reared at WDFW facilities that were released at 10 to 600 fish per pound. Trout fry/fingerlings released in 2016 will harvestable in 2017. Kokanee fry/fingerlings released in 2016 will be harvestable in fall 2018/spring 2019.
