COASTAL RECREATIONAL FISHING MESSAGE Number 6

This information about the Washington coast's recreational fishing was recorded September 6, 2018.

COASTAL SALMON SEASON

U. S. – Canada border to Cape Falcon, Oregon.

Marine Areas 1, 2, 3, and 4 are closed to salmon fishing for the remainder of 2018.

Area 2.1 [east of a line from Leadbetter Point to Cape Shoalwater (Willapa Bay)]:

August 1-Jan. 31: min. size 12". Daily limit 6 (combined). Up to 3 adults may be retained, of which only one may be a coho. Release wild Chinook. The Willapa Bay Control Zone is closed. August 1-September 30: The North River closure area is in effect. Anglers may fish with 2 poles with a Two-Pole Endorsement August 1 – January 31.

Area 2.2 [east of a line between tips of exposed jetties (Grays Harbor)]:

August 1-September 15: Humptulips North Bay Fishery, Min. size 12", Daily limit 2 (combined). Release wild Coho. October 1 – November 30: East Grays Harbor Fishery, Min size 12". Daily Limit 1. Release Chinook.
