Undesignated Crewmember License Information

Up to two crewmember licenses may be purchased and held by a commercial fishing license holder for use by any individual working on the vessel designated on the commercial fishing license. For this version, a crewmember license covers a single crewmember per trip, but the same crewmember license may be used to authorize a different individual to be a crewmember on a subsequent trip.

Undesignated crewmember licenses **can only be purchased when applying for or renewing a commercial fishing license**. The undesignated crewmember license fee applies to the crewmember's residency that the commercial fisher expects to cover. A **non-resident undesignated crewmember license can cover either a resident or non-resident**. When applying for or renewing a commercial fishing license, the commercial fisher has the option to buy up to two undesignated licenses, which can be two resident, two non-resident, or one resident and one non-resident.

The fee for an annual crewmember license is \$35 for residents and \$110 for non-residents. Non-residents also have the option of purchasing an albacore tuna crewmember license for a fee of \$35 that is only valid for albacore tuna and baitfish lampara fisheries.
