AGENCY APPROVAL (If requesting renewal): The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) has reviewed and certified the information provided above and finds that an animal problem potentially exists and that it cannot be reasonable abated by the use of nonlethal control tools or such nonlethal means cannot be reasonably applied. The issuance of a permit to this applicant for the requested removal constitutes approval by the WDFW.

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GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING REPORT OF WILDLIFE TAKEN UNDER A SPECIAL TRAPPING PERMIT

PROCEDURES:

Permit number: Entered from the permit for which you are reporting animals taken.

Permittee information: Enter the same information that was recorded on your permit under PERMITTEE.

Wildlife taken: Enter the common name of the species taken, the number of animals authorized on your permit and the number of animals taken. Disposition for targeted species may be relocated, euthanized, released on site, or none (Euthanized would also be used for animals taken in a Conibear-type trap or a drowning set). If a non-targeted animal was taken, indicate whether it was released on site or it could not be released.

Requesting renewal of permit: Mark **YES** if the animal problem has not been alleviated through the use of the permit and you are requesting renewal of the permit for an additional 30 day period. You will need to complete the **Justification for Renewal**. Only one renewal per permit is authorized.

Mark **NO** if the animal problem has been alleviated through the use of the permit or is just no longer needed.

Justification for Renewal: This section must be completed if you marked **YES** for renewal. Your justification should include the type of the animal problem that is continuing in spite of your efforts, damage that continues and the extent of damage, and the extent of damage that will be experienced if the permitted activities are not continued.

APPLICANT CERTIFICATION: To be signed by the applicant if requesting renewal of a permit.

AGENCY APPROVAL: Permit will be issued if renewal is granted.
