Maps in this series include: LT Murray, Wenas, Oak Creek, Ahtanum, Nanaimo / Colocum, Whiskey Dick / Quilomene

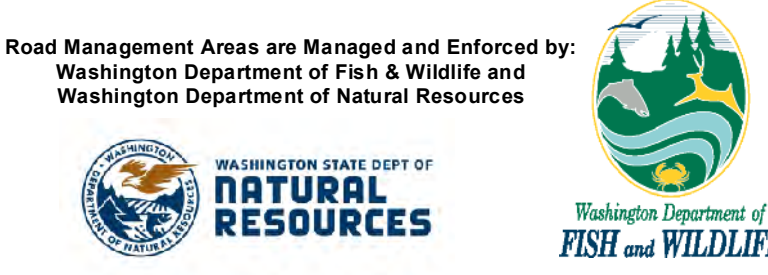
MotORIZED use is restricted to green dot roads only. Travel on non-green dot roads is restricted to 100' from its intersection with a green dot road. Travel on any roads not identified on the green dot map shall be considered off road vehicle travel. Off road vehicle travel is prohibited unless otherwise posted. Vehicles with electric motors are considered motorized.

Green Dot Roads are posted with round green reflectors on white route markers. Violators will be subject to prosecution.

- Green Dot Road Program Objectives**
- Prevent destruction & degradation of cultural resources and historic sites
 - Create high quality wildlife habitat in areas closed to vehicles
 - Provide a better hunting experience while reducing poaching of big game
 - Reduce costly road maintenance and repair
 - Protect streams & fish habitat by reducing the runoff of debris caused by roads and vehicles

- How You Can Help**
- Obey all posted regulatory signs
 - Don't blaze a new road or trail or cut switchbacks
 - Stay off soft, wet roads and trails easily torn up by vehicles
 - Pack out your garbage and litter left by others

ROAD MANAGEMENT AREA REGULATIONS

No vehicle camping allowed beyond 100 feet of open roads unless otherwise posted.

No permanent camps or structures allowed. All man-made materials must be removed.

No woodcutting without landowner permit. Do not cut live or standing dead trees under any circumstances. Down wood less than 12" in diameter may be collected for on-site camp wood.

Follow posted regulations for campfires. Public users are liable at all times for their fires.

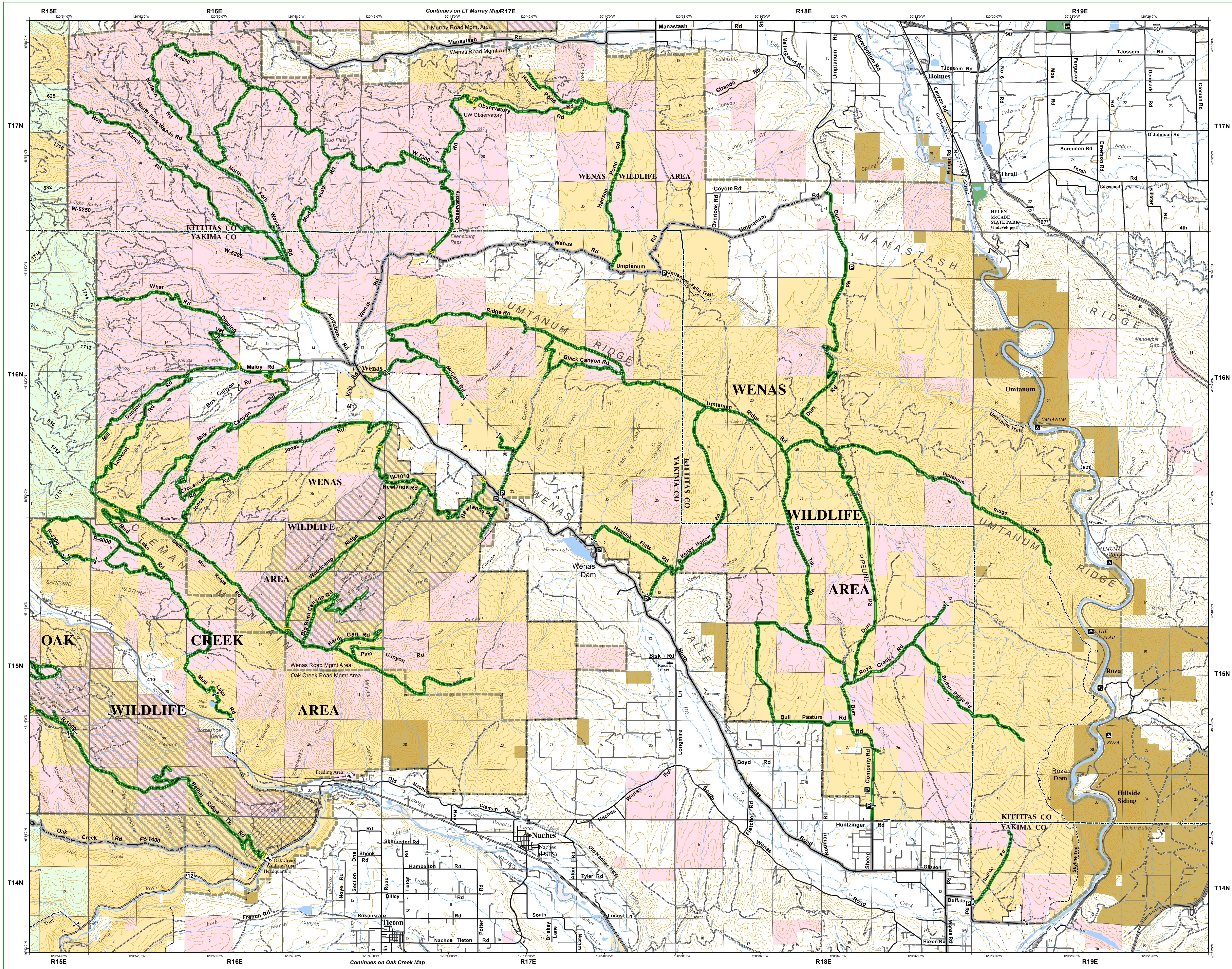
No fireworks or incendiary devices allowed at any time.

No littering, pack out your trash.
