EMERGENCY RULE

Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to open Reiter Ponds in the Skykomish River to fishing events for juvenile anglers only which will provide angling opportunity. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.



NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-04000N Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040, effective one hour before official sunrise to 12:00 noon on June 1, July 6 and August 3, 2019, it is permissible for juvenile anglers only to fish in those waters of the Skykomish River from the Reiter Ponds outlet to 500 feet downstream of the Reiter Ponds outlet.
