Reasons for this finding: This emergency rule is needed to ensure a successful Kids Fishing event. The closure is needed before the event as the fish will be planted in the lake two days prior to the event to better acclimate them. On the day of the event only children 14 years of age or less will be allowed to fish in the lake. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-04000Q Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040, effective 12:01 a.m. May 29 through June 1, 2019, it is unlawful to fish in those waters of Heart Lake, except open to fishing 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. June 1, 2019, to anglers participating in the kids fishing event. Juvenile anglers can continue to fish on June 1, 2019, after the kids fishing event closes.
