## NEW SECTION

**WAC 220-340-49000C Coastal crab Fishery – Coastal Crab Gear Recovery Permit.** Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-340-490:

- (1) Effective 8:01 AM September 16, 2019 until 11:59 PM October 31, 2019, a coastal crab gear recovery permit may be granted by the director or his or her designee for licensed coastal Dungeness crab fishers to recover crab pots belonging to state licensed fishers that remain in the ocean in the coastal waters between the Washington/Oregon border (46<sup>0</sup>15.00) and the US/Canada border, including the Columbia River, Willapa Bay and Grays Harbor.
- (2) No crab may be retained on any vessel engaged in permitted gear recovery activities or while recovered gear is on board the vessel.
