NEW SECTION

WAC 220-354-18000K Puget Sound salmon—Reef net open periods.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-354-180, effective immediately until further notice, it is unlawful to take, fish for, or possess salmon taken for commercial purposes in Puget Sound Salmon Management and Catch Reporting Areas except in accordance with the open periods, mesh size, areas, species restrictions, notification, and landing requirements set forth in this section, provided that unless otherwise amended, all permanent rules remain in effect:

(1) **Reef nets** - Open to reef nets according to the times, dates, and conditions as prescribed and listed below:

Area	Open Periods
7	Open 5 a.m. – 9 p.m. September 13, 2019
	Open 12 p.m. – 8 p.m. September 14, 2019

(a) Release all sockeye, unmarked Chinook, unmarked coho and chum.

(b) It is unlawful to fish for salmon with gill net gear in Areas 7 and 7A unless the vessel operator has attended a "Fish Friendly" best fishing practices workshop and is in possession of a department issued certification card.

REPEALERS
