Below is the weekly update for Willapa Bay. The weekly updates are now being posted to the commercial salmon fishery page on our website. See the last link at the bottom of the page. It will be listed under Willapa Bay.

Willapa Bay Commercial Fishery and Monitoring

The commercial fishery closed at the end of last week (week 41) on October 11. The fishery will remain closed until November 4, when it will reopen. Coho catch has been much lower than predicted to-date through week 41. The number of hatchery Chinook landed to-date was considerably lower compared to the preseason prediction. Effort was very low last week than anticipated in our model. Currently to-date through stat week 41, we are below the prediction for unmarked Chinook encounters, coho, and chum. Naselle Hatchery:

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There is a new Chinook program release goal for the Naselle Hatchery starting this year of 5,000,000. Last year's program release goal was 2,500,000 Chinook. This additional production is directed at increasing prey availability for Southern Resident Killer Whales. To-date, we have spawned 557 female Chinook. To make the new program goal, we still need an additional 1,110 female Chinook. Currently, we have an estimated 200 adult Chinook on-hand in the pond. These fish are a mix of males and females.

Nemah Hatchery:

The Chinook program release goal for the Nemah Hatchery is 3,300,000. To-date, we have spawned 357 female Chinook. To make program goal we still need an additional 743 female Chinook. Currently, we have an estimated 130 adult Chinook on-hand in the pond. These fish are a mix of males and females.

Forks Creek Hatchery:

There is a new Chinook program release goal for Forks Creek Hatchery starting this year of 400,000. Last year's program release goal was 350,000 Chinook. This additional production is directed at increasing prey availability for Southern Resident Killer Whales. To-date, we have spawned 502 female Chinook. That is enough females to make the program release goal. Currently, we have an estimated 114 adult Chinook on-hand in the facility. These fish are a mix of males and females.

Due to the weather that is started yesterday and will continue for the next few days, the river level is going to rise. With that, we are likely to see more Chinook volunteer into our facilities.

Spawning Ground Surveys

We are currently in the peak weeks for our Chinook indexes and supplementals. We started all of our Chum indexes as well a few weeks ago. Chinook mortalities are currently at normal levels. To-date, we have seen live chum in the rivers but only a few chum spawning in our spawning ground surveys. To get ahead of the weather and rain that is currently here, our staff started our weekly indexes and supplementals on Sunday and all surveys were completed yesterday.

Willapa Bay Salmon Advisory Group:

We have scheduled two advisory group meetings; one October 24 and one November 21. The purpose of these meetings is to review the draft comprehensive review document. These meetings are open to the public and both meetings will be held at the Raymond Elk Lodge in Raymond, WA from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. The meetings have been posted to the advisory group page of our website. The link to the Willapa Bay advisory group page on our website is listed below.

As always, in-season data is preliminary and subject to change.


