THE FOLLOWING FISHERIES WERE SET:

<i>2019 Sturgeon Recreational Fishery for Above Wauna</i>	
Season:	Saturday October 12 1 day
Area:	Mainstem Columbia River from the Wauna powerlines upstream to Bonneville Dam, including the Cowlitz River
Allowable Catch:	Up to 540 white sturgeon Legal size: 44-inch minimum and 50-inch maximum fork length (Fork length is measured in a straight line from the tip of the nose to the fork in the caudal fin (tail) with the fish laying on its side on a flat surface, with the tape measure/ruler positioned flat <u>under</u> the fish)
Additional Regulations:	Daily bag limit: One fish Annual bag limit: Two fish Retention of green sturgeon is prohibited

FUTURE MEETINGS

- Staff will continue to monitor the fisheries and stock status and recommend additional hearings as needed.
