NEW SECTION

WAC 220-312-06000C Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River. Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-060:

From Wauna powerlines upstream to Bonneville Dam, including the Cowlitz River:

- (a) It is permissible to retain white sturgeon on the following dates: October 19 and October 24, 2019. The daily limit of white sturgeon is one fish between 44-inches minimum and 50-inches maximum fork length.
- (b) Catch and release angling is permissible on days not open to sturgeon retention.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective October 25, 2019:
