WAC 220-313-06000M Puget Sound salmon—saltwater seasons and daily limits. Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-313-060, effective immediately:

- 1. Catch Record Card Area 8-1, effective immediately through October 31, 2019:
 - (a) Release all pink salmon.
 - (b) No more than 1 coho may be retained as part of the salmon daily limit.
- 2. Catch Record Card Area 10:
 - (a) Effective immediately through November 15, 2019: Release all Chinook salmon.
 - (b) Effective immediately through November 15, 2019: No more than 1 coho may be retained as part of the salmon daily limit.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective immediately:

WAC 220-313-06000L Puget Sound salmon-saltwater seasons and daily limits. (19-230)
