WAC 220-330-16000H Razor clams – Areas and Seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-160, it is unlawful to take, dig for or possess razor clams taken for personal use from any beaches in any razor clam area except as provided for in this section:

- Effective 12:01 p.m. October 26, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. November 1, 2019, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 1. Digging is permissible from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (2) Effective 12:01 p.m. October 26, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. November 1, 2019, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 3. Digging is permissible from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (3) Effective 12:01 p.m. October 26, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. October 26, 2019, and 12:01 p.m. October 28, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. October 28, 2019, and 12:01 p.m. October 30, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. October 30, 2019, and 12:01 p.m. November 1, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. November 1, 2019, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 4. Digging is permissible from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (4) Effective 12:01 p.m. October 27, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. October 27, 2019, and 12:01 p.m. October 29, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. October 29, 2019, and 12:01 p.m. October 31, 2019 through 11:59 p.m. October 31, 2019, razor clam digging is permissible in Razor Clam Area 5. Digging is permissible from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (5) It is unlawful to dig for razor clams at any time in the Long Beach, Twin Harbors and Copalis Beach Clam sanctuaries defined in WAC 220-320-130.
