NEW SECTION

WAC 220-330-04000I Crab--Areas and Seasons—Personal use.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-330-040, effective November 28, 2019 until further notice, it is unlawful to fish for crab for personal use in Puget Sound in all waters of Marine Areas, 4 east of the Bonilla-Tatoosh line, 5, 6, 7, 8-1, 8-2, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13, except as provided herein:

Marine Area 4 east of the Bonilla-Tatoosh line, Marine Area 5, Marine Area 6, Marine Area 7, Marine Area 8-1, Marine Area 8-2 and Marine Area 9, except those waters between the Hood Canal Bridge to a line connecting Foulweather Bluff to Olele Point, are open to fish for crab for personal use.
