WAC 220-312-04000F Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound. Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-312-040:

(1) **Nooksack River (Whatcom Co.):** from the Lummi Indian Reservation boundary to the confluence of the North and South Forks; salmon, effective November 28 through December 31, 2019:

Daily limit 2, plus 2 additional hatchery coho. Release pinks and chum.

(2) Nooksack River, North Fork (Whatcom Co.): from the Hwy. 9 Bridge to Maple Creek; salmon, effective November 28 through November 30, 2019:

Daily limit 2, plus 2 additional hatchery coho. Release pinks and chum.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective January 1, 2020:

WAC 220-312-04000F Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.
