




Project Description	Acquisition of this 20-acre riparian project would provide protection of a known holding pool and staging area for native summer run steelhead.
Project Benefits	The falls present a stream flow barrier to anadromous fish during winter and spring making the area impassable for a time to steelhead until flows drop at the falls and allow them to continue migration. The site also is an important monitoring location for steelhead and provides recreational opportunities for kayakers moving through the property and on to downstream areas.
