Hi Charity,

Thank you for your review of the Wells Boat Launch project and for your questions. Work will occur at the rock pile and in the general footprint of the existing boat launch, with only minimal impact beyond the edges of the existing launch area. The existing launch area will be improved to eliminate turbidity generated from boat trailers launching on soft sediments. Impacts to the shoreline will be mitigated by removing the hardened shoreline rock pile (318 sf) on the northeast corner of the project footprint, increasing natural shoreline and enhancing nearshore habitat. If required, permits will be conditioned to meet additional mitigation requirements.
