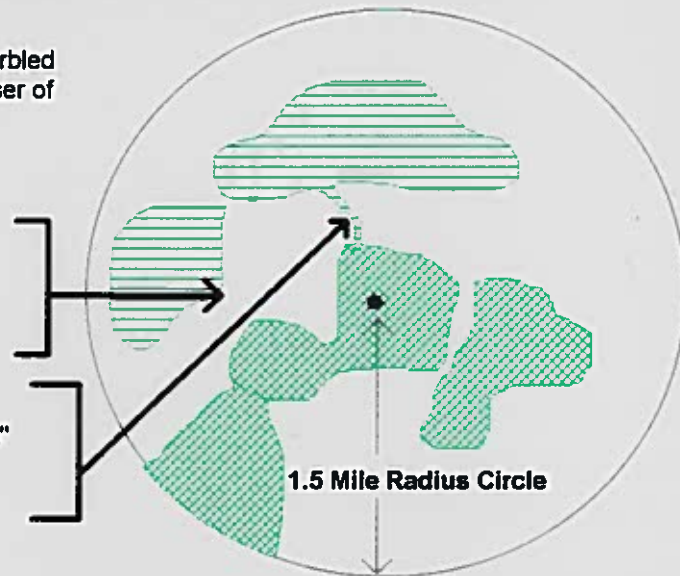


## How To Determine The Outer Perimeter Of An Occupied Stand

**You are required to establish the "Occupied Marbled Murrelet Site" boundary as defined in WAC 222-16-010**

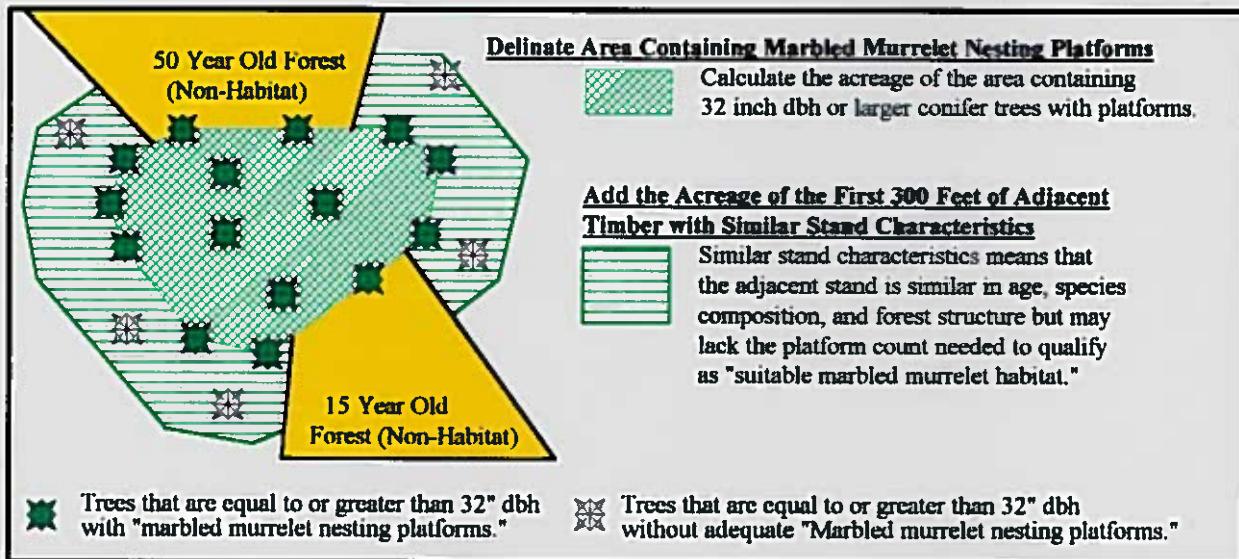
The outer perimeter of an "occupied marbled murrelet site" is presumed to be the closer of the following:

1. 1.5 miles from the point where the occupied behaviors occurred.
2. The beginning of any gap greater than 300 feet that lacks any of the vegetative characteristics listed under "suitable marbled murrelet habitat."
3. The beginning of any narrow area of "suitable marbled murrelet habitat" less than 300 feet wide and more than 300 feet in length

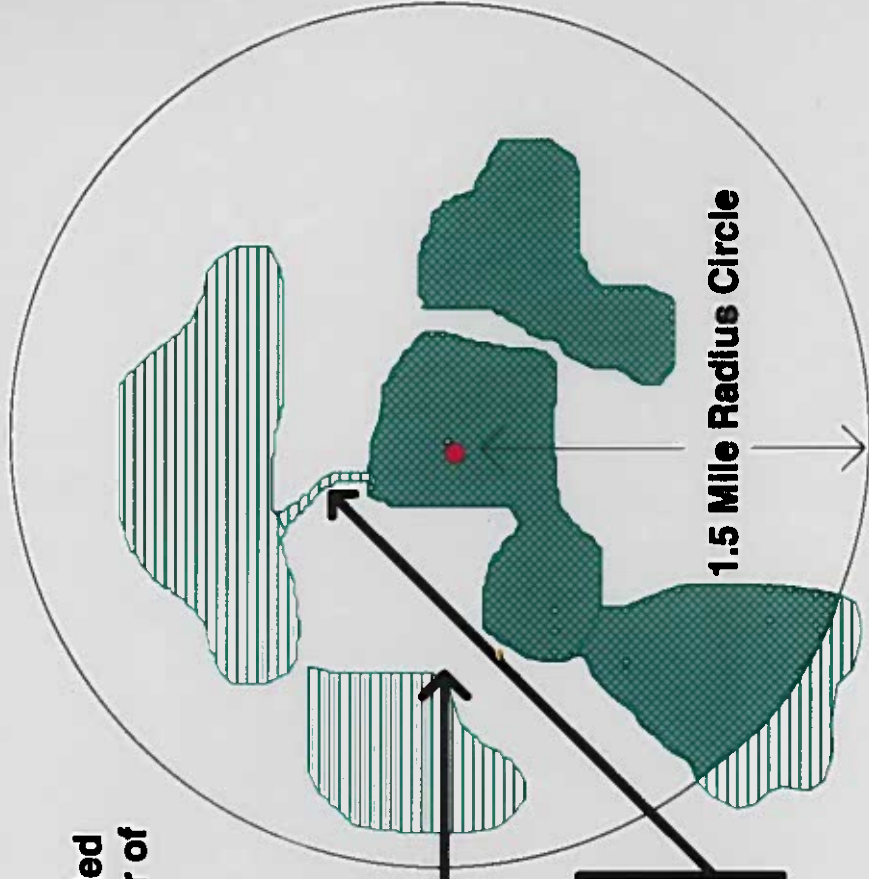


# Occupied Site Boundary Determination

Non-Contiguous Suitable Habitat

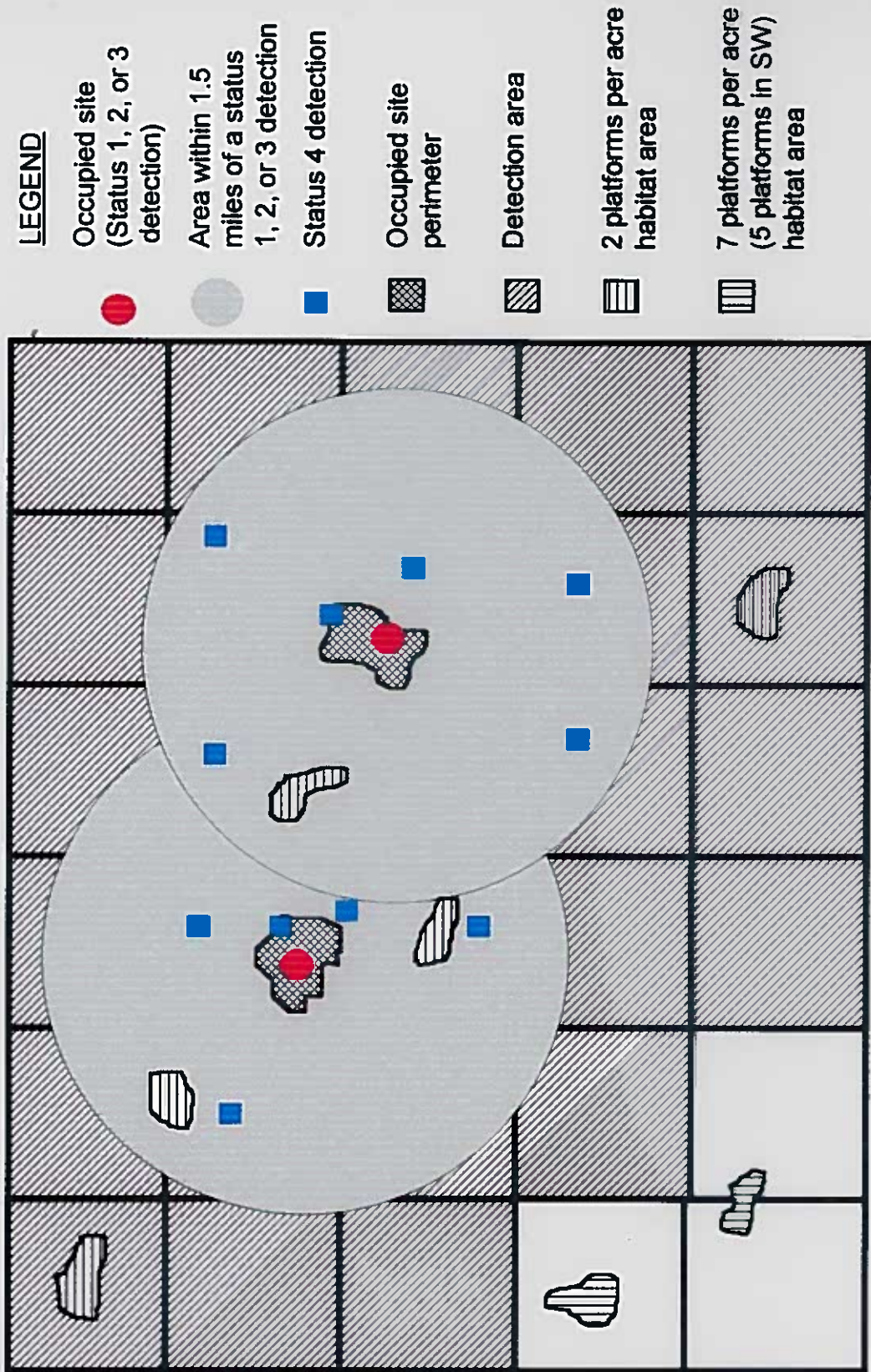


Land Not Meeting Suitable Habitat Criteria
