- Low impact trail system

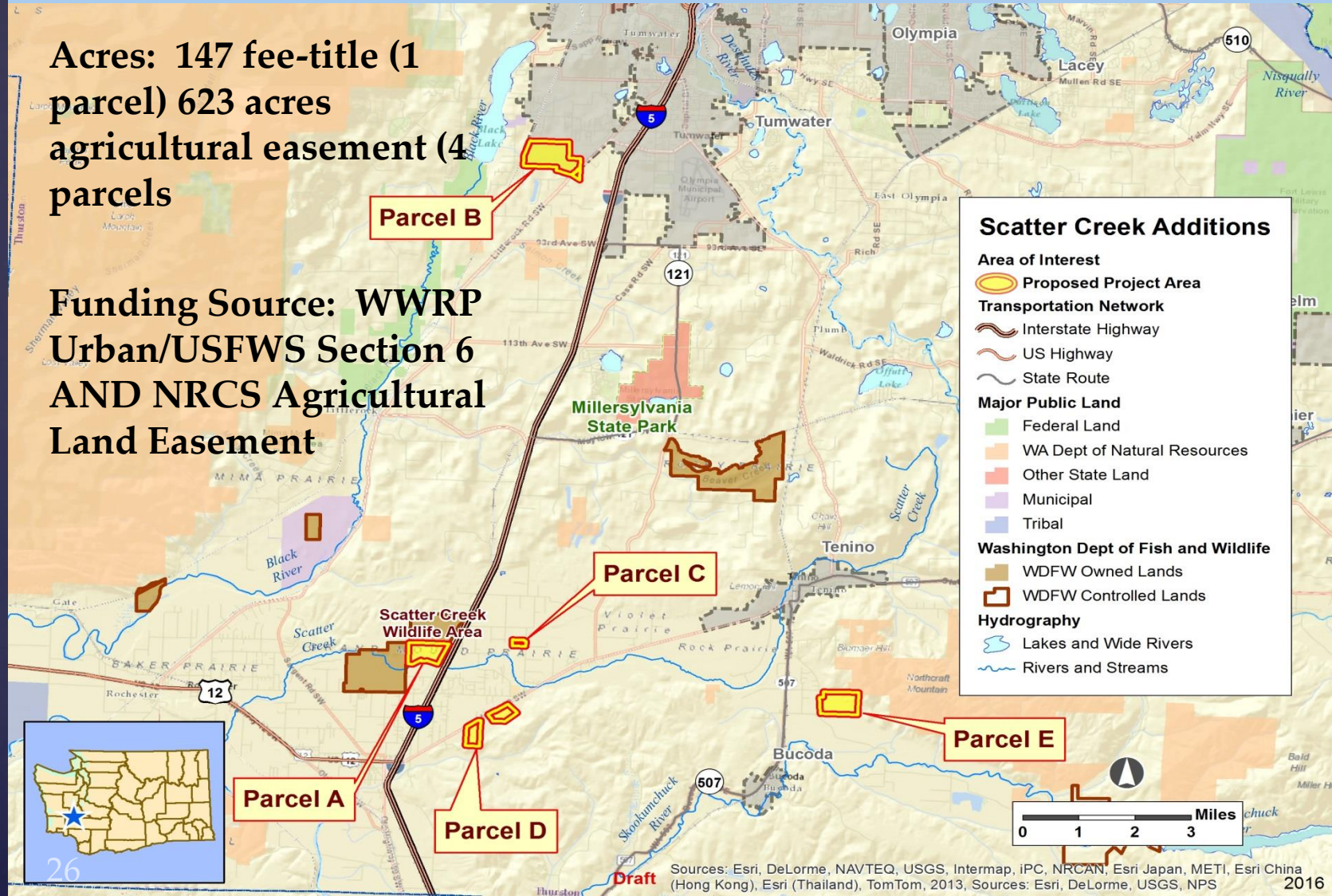
