



- Model fisheries to determine which stocks are the constraints
- Predict what we will catch
- Depending on the area, negotiate with treaty Indian tribes and other states



# 2020 Management Objectives

Fish and Wildlife Commission unanimously adopted interim guidance on February 7, 2020. The Department is directed to carry forward the 2019 guidance except for:

- UM Chinook
  - Reduce impact rate to 14%
- Coho
  - · Manage for aggregate escapement
- Chum
  - 10% terminal impact rate cap
  - No commercial fisheries Oct. 15 to Oct. 31
