Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the **Skagit Wildlife Area Boat Launch Repair** Project. Based on review of the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist associated with this Project, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) has the following comments:

- Section B.1.h: Please expand upon the proposed measures to reduce and control erosion on the project should it occur, as identified in in response to B.1.f.
- Section B.3.a1: In the first sentence, please indicate the name of the surface water body that the boat ramp accesses.
- Section B.3.c1: Runoff to Wiley Slough will most likely increase due to the expanded area of the ramp and the decrease in wetlands.
- Site Plan: It would be helpful to show the current boat ramp and the area of wetlands that will be removed due to construction of the new boat ramp.
