Hi Lisa,

We received a comment from Ecology (Shannon Adams) which expressed confusion as to the footprint of total ground disturbance as a result of the project. Depending on the level of ground disturbance, Shannon implied in her SEPA comment that we may need a Construction Stormwater General Permit. I called Shannon to inquire further and we discussed over the phone the location of the project and the footprint of disturbance. I clarified that the total disturbance was 2 acres but Shannon stated because the project area receives relatively little rainfall, we qualify for an Erosivity Waiver. I submitted the Erosivity Waiver to Shannon Adams through email on Tuesday April 8<sup>th</sup>. On Wednesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, I received confirmation through email from Miya Spratt that the Erosivity Waiver had been received by Ecology. This acknowledgement of the receipt of the Erosivity Waiver documents that the comment from Ecology was addressed and it was determined that we do not need a Construction Stormwater General Permit but rather an Erosivity Waiver applied for through Ecology for the Lind Coulee West Bridge Access Redevelopment.
