Thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on this project. The project area is in very close proximity (200-300 feet) from a tribal pre-contact site. However, it does not appear that this project will impact the cultural site as far as we can tell at this time. If there should be any ground disturbing activity on, or west of, Davis Slough, we would have concerns. At this time, we would request notification of ground disturbance for this project, and that an Inadvertent Discovery Plan be in place.
