Good afternoon,

Thank you for your review of the Teanaway Community Forest Grazing Improvements project. The description of the project in the SEPA checklist indicates that work will occur below the OHWM in six locations on four streams. We have submitted a JARPA and permit drawings as the CWA 404 application to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. We will provide the JARPA and completed drawings to Ecology for review under the CWA 401. We have been in contact with Kittitas County Community Development Services regarding critical areas, shoreline and floodplain in the vicinity of the project site and will apply for all necessary permits and reviews.

Straw wattles or compost socks will be employed where needed at all the project sites. Sheet 22 in the permit drawings identifies further erosion control measures during hardened crossing installation and adjustment of the bank slopes. These measures include installing bags filled with pea gravel to seal bypass inlet prior to starting work, installing haybales downstream of the work area past the bypass pipe to catch any sediment and allow it to settle before allowing water to flow through the channel, and covering all exposed soil with straw mulch and grass seed on the banks.
