- All participants MUST have attended a "Fish Friendly" best fishing practices workshop and have in their immediate possession a department-issued certification card.
- Retention of White or Green Sturgeon Prohibited. Please report ALL encounters to Wholesale Dealer or through the Quick Reporting phone, fax, or email.

- Live box use REQUIRED for All wild (unmarked) Chinook and All Steelhead.
- Soak times must not exceed 45 minutes.
- **Notice of Intent to fish any of the days in the 2020 fisheries is REQUIRED by 12 pm (Noon), October 9, 2020.**
