WDFW appreciates the comments from Ecology.

WDFW did reach out to discuss Toxics Cleanup, but has not received a response prior to submitting this response. WDFW is not aware of any current toxic issues at the site, and should something happen during construction, WDFW will contact Ecology and work to remedy the situation, while also immediately acting to correct the issue.

WDFW did reach out to Mr. Benge and discussed the project. After a short description of the project, we agreed this project did not require coverage under the Construction Stormwater General Permit. WDFW will have Temporary Erosion and Sediment Control elements in place to prevent adverse effects to the Elochoman River.
