## Commission Guidance

#### **December 2020**

- Incorporate appropriate suggestions for grammatic, wording, and readability improvements and technical lapses, such verbiage duplications and Appendix 3 not including a schedule.
- Add clarifying or additional descriptive language regarding limits to increases in hatchery production that would be enabled by changes currently being considered to Policy C-3619, and the process by which any increase in hatchery production might occur.
- Provide additional language responsive to the Tribal input from the December
   2 Tribal Co-Manager meeting on the November 6 public review draft.
- Consider adding clarifying or more descriptive language consistent with the policy intent expressed by the Commission to date.

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

(2) Minimize environmental risks from production



## **Policy Implementation Summary**

- 1. Develop technical procedures document [Risk Management Framework].
  - Outreach Tribal co-managers
  - Assemble document development team
  - Periodic progress reports to Commission
  - Draft final report
  - Public comment
  - SEPA Review
  - Final report
- 2. Develop HMPs based on prioritization in Policy
- Existing hatchery operational plans, goals and objectives in effect on June 14, 2018 shall remain intact as current policy direction
- ❖ Begin development of a joint policy agreement on salmon and steelhead hatchery programs with Tribal Co-Managers
